

MUSICAL EXAMPLES BY 18TH-CENTURY BIPOC COMPOSERS

This is a compilation of analytical notes on 18th-century music included in the [Composers of Color Resource Project](#) and a list of 18th-century examples, organized by topic, from the website [Diverse Music Theory Examples](#). (Both resources are regularly updated, these lists include only works that appeared by June 21, 2021.)

Given the limited amount of available scores by BIPOC composers writing in the 18th century, it is crucial to avoid tokenism. Cara Stroud's "[Practical Suggestions for Including Examples from Women Composers in the Music Theory Curriculum](#)" (2018) are equally useful for including examples by BIPOC composers. To avoid tokenism, Stroud recommends including at least two pieces per semester and not grouping them together.
